The Ombú is a native tree of South America. In our winery there is one Ombú where the previous landowners use to hide golden coins, so my family always thought there is a treasure buried there. But we believe the real treasure is our vineyard that allows us to produce this exclusive wine for you!

Our vineyard is located 8 km away from sea. This allow us to produce wines with a unique breeze affection getting a delicate maturation, aromatic and freshness notes and fantastic acidity balance.

In this range "no pre concepts" we try to rescue grapes that have been abandoned or underrated but belong to our past culture and are an important part of our heritage like it is Moscatal.
